

VIRGINIA BEACH SENIORS GOLF CLUB

First in review: Our club normally utilizes a modified Stableford scoring system (36 minus handicap). In example, a golfer with a 22 handicap has to make 14 points (36 minus 22=14) to be even using the following point system. If he scores 17 he is plus 3 or scoring 12 makes him minus 2.

[Points earned : Over Bogey = 0, Bogey = 1, Par =2, Birdie = 4, Eagle = 6]

GUIDELINES FOR KEEPING SCORECARDS

If we all do a good job of recording our scores, the monthly scoring committee members will be better able to publish results quicker.

“The attached scorecard shows the preferred, ideal way to keep your team’s score.”

Please write legibly.

Enter the LAST name of each player AND his established handicap.

To calculate your team points subtract each player’s VBSGC handicap from 36 and then add those results which is the team’s break-even goal. Note somewhere near the bottom of the card this calculated number as your team’s points objective.

Add each player’s score and his points for each side plus enter all totals on the card.

Do not enter a score on any hole for a player that exceeds his maximum allowed score, based on his handicap, as follows:

Equitable Stroke Control

This table sets a maximum number that a player can post on any hole based on his handicap. .

Handicap	Maximum Score
9 or less	Double Bogey
10 – 19	(7)
20 - 29	(8)
30 or above	(9)

When we play the tournament rounds, enter actual scores. (No maximum)

Please note on the card the number of the hole where your team began play.

Keep two scorecards, one in each cart. Team Captain submits the most legible scorecard to the committee. Circle at lower right of scorecard the number your team is above or below their objective.

Be ready with your team’s money and scores before you approach the committee table. This speeds up the final scoring significantly and reduces confusion.
